SUBJECT: Command Policy Letter 7, Child Supervision and Juvenile Curfew Policy

1. Reference memorandum, HQ USAREUR/7A, AEAGA-GY, 7 Aug 02, subject: USAREUR Child-Supervision Policy, and any amendment or supplement thereto.
2. Safeguarding children is the responsibility of parents and guardians. Parents and guardians shall provide the necessary safety, shelter, guidance, and other life needs to ensure proper development and well-being of children under their care. This policy sets forth the child-supervision policy and the juvenile curfew hours observed within the 284th Base Support Battalion (BSB) area of responsibility (AOR).
3. This policy applies 24-hours a day, seven days a week, to 284th BSB supported personnel who are parents or legal guardians of children who live with them and have not graduated from high school. For the purpose of this policy, "284th BSB supported personnel" include service members, family members, DoD civilian employees (including employees of AAFES and DoDDS), and contractors.
4. The provisions of Reference are hereby adopted in their entirety and are fully applicable within the 284th BSB AOR.
5. Juvenile curfew hours for the 284th BSB AOR are 2200-0500. During these hours, all children 18 years old and younger will be indoors in addition to being supervised in accordance with Reference.
6. Exceptions to this policy include children who are (a) accompanied by their sponsoring parent or guardian, (b) in bona fide emergencies, (c) returning home from community or school sponsored functions, or (d) returning home from place of employment.
7. Due to developmental differences, chronological age or grade level will not be the only factor in determining lack of proper supervision or neglect. All cases will be assessed on their own merit.
8. Violators of this policy may be subject to adverse action pursuant to UCMJ, AER 27-9, or other applicable Army in Europe, Army, DoD, or host nation regulations, including, but not limited to, termination of privileges of occupying government quarters or use of government facilities.


