## Parents on Camp Trips

If you are on one of our SAS trips, we request that you follow the rules that SAS has for staff and children and the bus company. You may also choose to take your own child around the park on your own and just meet us at the designated meeting area and time. Some of the rules we follow include the following:

- Eat or pack healthy foods only.
- Be on time.
- Sit facing the front of the bus for safety.
- Keep aisles free of items to include legs and feet.

Also, make sure that you have paid for your entrance fee BEFORE we leave SAS. Otherwise, you have to pay on your own at the park and will be charged regular rates. No money exchange will be conducted when we are ready to leave the facility, while traveling in the bus, and when we get to the park.
